In 2022, Richmond International Airport (RIC) soared with a record-setting cargo volume of nearly 160 million pounds. Air carriers include FedEx, UPS, DHL, and Southwest. And in 2020, the airport welcomed Amazon Air, making it one of more than 30 airports across the major cargo airline's network. Business was also surging at the Port of Virginia, which uniquely owns and operates its terminals. In 2022, container-volume growth spiked 25% in one year to make it the fastest-growing port in the country.
